## 72.07 PARKING ON PARADE ROUTE

- (A) the Chief of Police or other authorized city official shall have authority, whenever in his judgement it is necessary, to prohibit or restrict the parking of vehicles along a street or part thereof constituting a part of the route of a parade or procession, to erect temporary traffic signs to that effect, and to prohibit and prevent such parking.
- (B) It shall be unlawful to park or leave unattended any vehicle in violation of such signs or directions. Penalty, see 72.99
