CHAPTER: PROHIBITING UNREASONABLE NOISE

368 PROHIBITING UNREASONABLE NOISE IN THE CITY

(A) No person shall cause unreasonable noise in the City of Highland Heights, Campbell County, Kentucky, nor shall he permit unreasonable noise upon premises owned or controlled by him.

(B) Unreasonable noise is defined as a noise level sufficient to prevent persons of ordinary sensibilities not on the premises where the noise occurs from engaging in normal activities with a reasonable degree of concentration between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. Between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. unreasonable noise shall consist of that level of noise which will interfere with the sleep of a person of ordinary sensibilities not residing on the premises where the noise occurs. In determining the reasonableness of the level of noise occurring between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. the court may consider whether such noise is a result of a business use and whether such noise is necessary concomitant of the business pursued.
