There were (2) callouts during the month of September.

The first was a collision that occurred in Highland Heights on September 7th, 2020. While traveling on I 275 eastbound a motorcycle attempted to stop in heavy traffic. The operator veered into the emergency lane to avoid striking another vehicle. The operator lost control laid the vehicle down on its side. The operator's wife was riding on the motorcycle with him. Neither was wearing a helmet. The passenger slid into the guardrail, struck her head killing her. Operator inexperience and unfamiliarity with the area are both believed to be a factor in the collision.

The second collision occurred on September 29, 2020 when a vehicle struck a tow truck in the 1200 block of Monmouth Street in Newport and flipped. The condition of the operator was unknown at the time of this report. Speed was considered to be a factor in this collision.

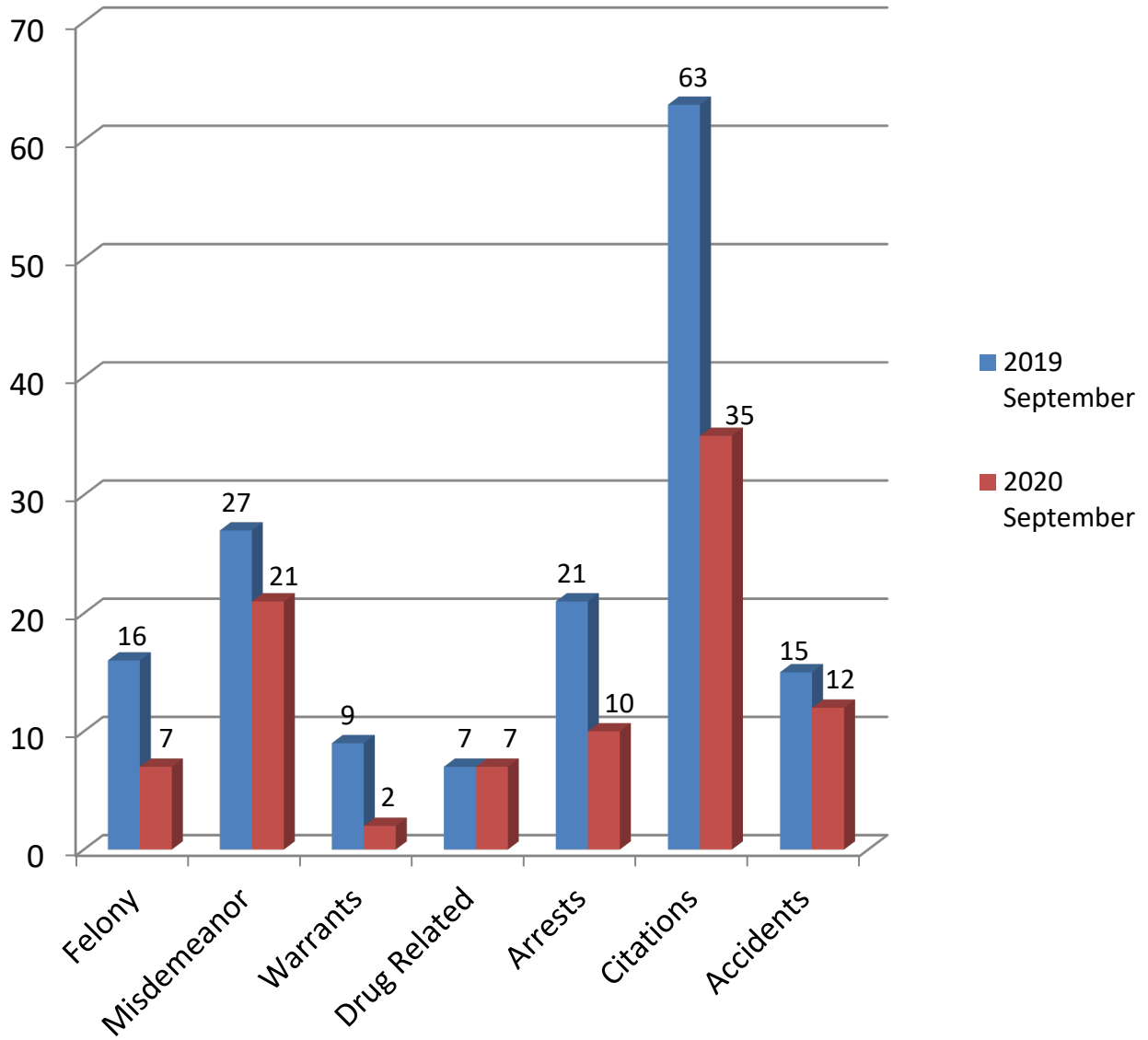
