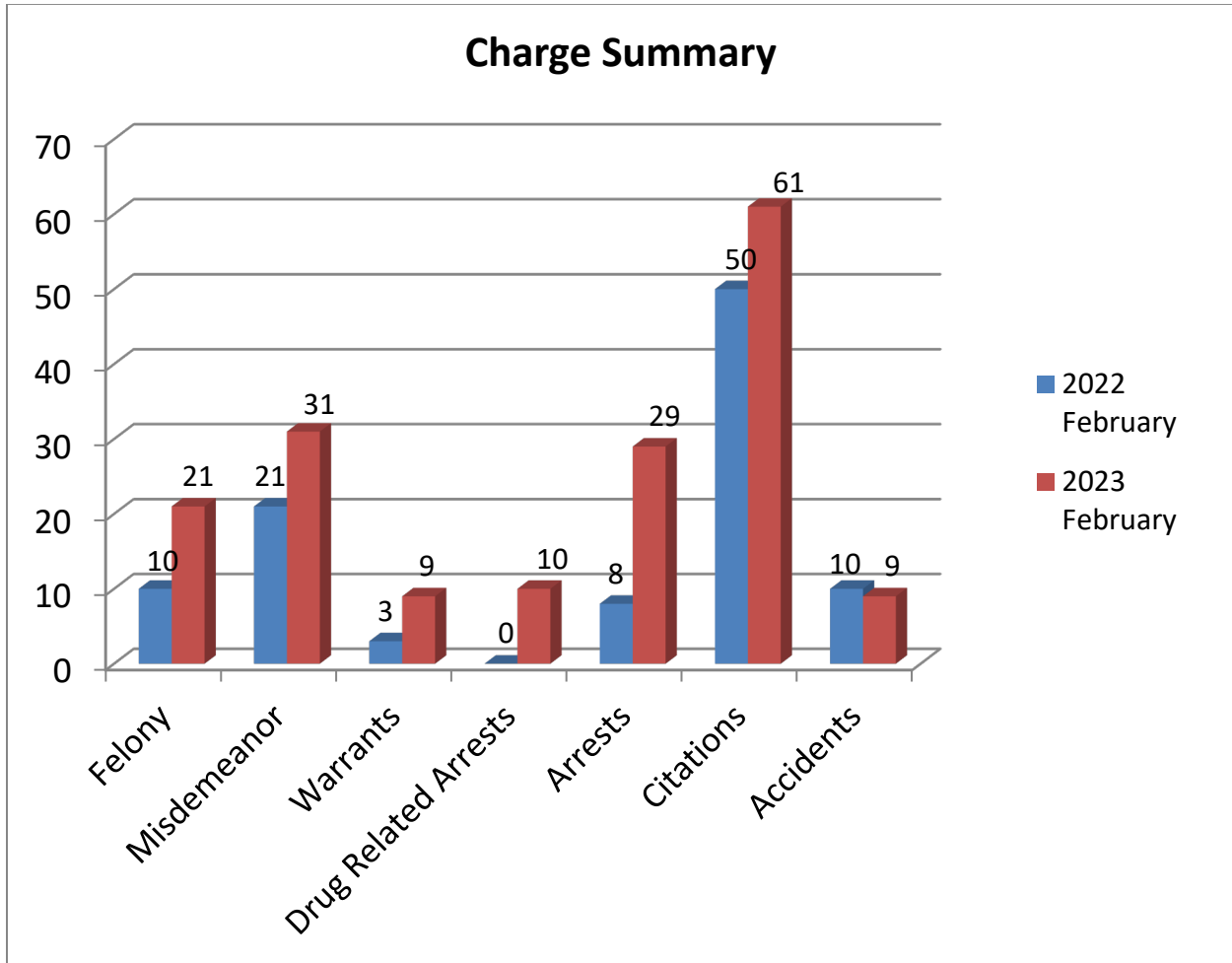

S.I.R.T. SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS RESPONSE TEAM

February 13th Collision with serious injuries AA Highway and Poplar ridge. Collision reconstruction and evidence collection after Alexandria Police requested SIRT respond. Alexandria Police still investigating with possible criminal charges.

February 17th Campbell County Police requested SIRT after an argument at Alexandria UDF where shots were fired. SIRT assisted in searching for evidence as well as making a plaster mold of tire tracks of the suspect vehicle. Suspect arrested for Wanton Endangerment 1st degree.

February 23rd Fort Thomas Police requested SIRT after a person was struck and killed by a train. CSX requires an outside agency complete the investigation. It was determined to be a suicide.
