

SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS RESPONSE TEAM

July 13th SIRT assisted Cold Spring Police with a Death Investigation. It was determined to be an overdose on medication and no charges were filed.

July 14th SIRT assisted Fort Thomas Police with a fatal accident on I 471. It was determined the tire came off a southbound dump truck then bounced across the center wall striking a vehicle traveling North I 471. The driver of the dump truck received a citation from Kentucky Vehicle Enforcement for multiple violations for commercial vehicle infractions. At this time the investigation is still pending for causing the fatal accident.

July 28th SIRT assisted Newport Police with a shooting that occurred during a large fight at a park. Criminal charges are pending.
