K9 Tiba and Lt. Conrad achieved their annual certification through North American Police Work Dog Association. This is a national certification that holds teams to a higher level above state standards. The certification is specific to the team and covers narcotic detection. The testing covers several areas that K9s will encounter, such as vehicle searches, rooms searches, and locker searches. K9 Tiba is trained to give a positive alert to heroin, methamphetamines, cocaine, and marijuana. Her alert is passive, which means that she sits and points with her nose where the narcotic odor is coming from. In addition to certification, she had several searches but nothing was located.

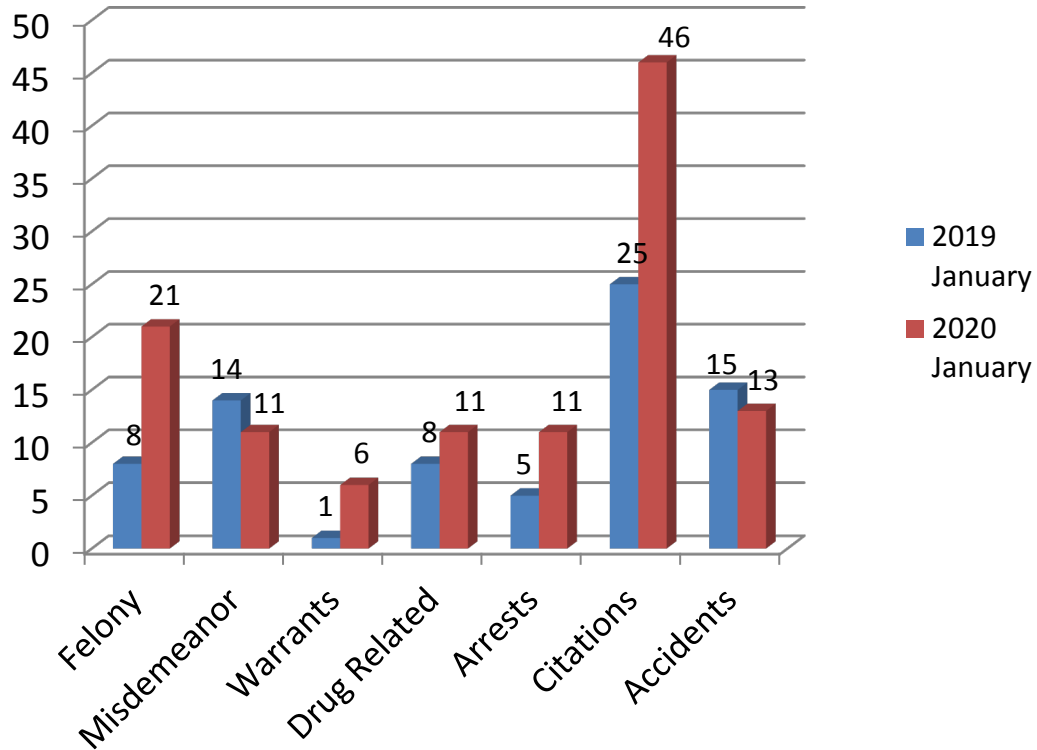
